This program has proved to be a National best practice and Fong is now contracted by Tennis Canada to implement leagues in clubs across the country.

Giguère is currently the Regional and Technical director at Tennis Quebec since 2005, he is also a course facilitator as well as responsible for implementing leagues in clubs and BTC's across the province of Quebec. Under Francois' Leadership, leagues have become a sustainable program attracting hundreds of kids annually to tennis in Quebec
