He is the founder of Capestany Tennis Inc. which runs tennis websites for players and coaches. Jorge’s programs have developed more than 180 HS State Tennis Champions in Michigan. He is an internationally recognized speaker that frequently presents at the most prestigious National and International tennis conferences.
