Scholarship Description:

A \$2000 scholarship will be presented annually to a TPA Tennis Coach that has demonstrated excellence in the U10 player development area.

The award will provide a scholarship to offset costs of professional development courses and seminars, including international, national and provincial conferences or seminars and/or certification courses approved by Tennis Canada.

Criteria Used in the Selection of this Award:

- Under 10 Player Results number of U9/U10 competitors participating in the U9/U10 advanced tour; number of players reaching provincial NTC program; number of players reaching national NTC program.
- Actively involved in working with the club's top U10 program/players
- Actively involved in coaching the club's red, orange and green court progressive programming
- > Involved in running U9 and U10 provincial sanctioned tournaments
- > Display a commitment of excellence towards the coaching profession.
- > Work full-time or towards a full-time career.
- > Espouse the values of fair play, professionalism, honesty and integrity.

Applicants must submit the following required information prior to January 18, 2018 to be considered:

- > One page resume.
- > One page letter expressing their goals.
- > Letter of reference from employer.
- A testimonial from a parent of an under 10 player who the candidate is coaching regularly.
- > Letter of approval from the applicant's provincial association.
