TDC Players Bonus Funding

BONUS FUNDING FOR TOP PLAYER RESULTS

The Bonus Funding Program is for TDC's which achieved a Gold, Silver or Bronze reward level in the current TDC cycle. This program offers three levels of assistance (described below) for TDC's having players meeting high performance standards. This funding is intended to offset the ongoing human and financial resources required to train and compete at the highest national and international level.

<u>Eligibility Criteria:</u> In order to qualify for a bonus grant a TDC must meet 4 of the criteria described in the table below. <u>The lowest of the "best four criteria" (from the Player & Program Section)</u> met will determine the bonus of the funding level granted. Please note that there needs to be at least one criteria met from the Player Section.
