

Instructions to Complete the Make Ethical Decision (MED) on-line


All Coaches and Pro's will be required to pass the on-line evaluation module – “Make Ethical Decisions”. **This is a mandatory requirement for certification.** You can access the on-line evaluation as follows:

Before you start the evaluation, you will need:

1. **Your CC number** – Please put this CC# in a safe place as you will require this number in order to take your on-line evaluation and it will be your NCCP passport number used in future certification.
2. You already received an email, in both languages, that provides you with your CC#, password, and instructions on accessing the NCCP database. Sometimes this email can be caught in a “junk” or “spam” folder, so if you has not received this e-mail, please check those folders first. If you still cannot find that email, you should contact coach@coach.ca and indicate “TENNIS COMP INT MED” in the subject line.
3. You will use this CC Number and password received in the email from the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC) to log into the MED on-line evaluation by clicking on the link below:






Please be advised:
