Dehart is a PTR Clinician for more than 40 years, who serves as the PTR representative for Northern California. He has been a presenter at many coach education events, including the PTR Italy Symposium, PTR Wimbledon Conferences, the PTR International Tennis Symposium, the USTA Tennis Teachers Conference, and four times at the Australian Open Coaches Conference. Currently, DeHart is the Director of Tennis at Silver Creek Valley Country Club.
